## The Youth

They come to Indiana United Methodist Children's Home from all over the state. They come from urban areas, small rural towns and suburban communities. Their problems are as varied as the places they come from. However, they do share a common bond. They need help dealing with

their emotional problems. The youth range in age from 6 to 18 and represent many social, economic and racial backgrounds.

## The Program

The youth are placed at the Home due to problems caused by physical, emotional, and sexual abuse or neglect and abandonment. Counseling, education, religious education, group living and recreation form the residential treatment program of the Children's Home. With the help of professionally trained staff, youth are shown ways to cope effectively with their problems. A majority of referrals come from social service agencies, public school systems, juvenile courts or by a concerned minister or family member.



## The Reason

Each year, more than 20,000 children are abused or neglected in Indiana. That's 56 children per day which would fill three typical classrooms.
