Many generous donors, organizations and congregations ask for suggestions of gifts which will directly help the residents in care. This list highlights some of the Home's current needs.

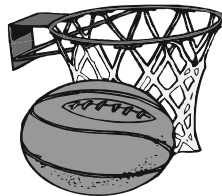
